

DOCUMENTS AND DATA REQUIRED FOR FILING IN HUNGARY

1. PATENTS AND UTILITY MODELS

- Applicant's name and address
- Inventor's name and address
- Specification, preferably in English, German or French, for translation into Hungarian
- Drawings, if any
- Power of Attorney
- Assignment Document, if applicant and inventor are not the same person
- Certificate of deposit of microorganisms, if the invention is based on the use of microorganisms

Additional requirements for convention applications

- Filing date, application number and country of each basic foreign application
- Certified copy of each basic foreign application, to be filed within 16 months from the earliest priority date
- Assignment Document, if applicant is not identical with the applicant(s) of the basic foreign application(s)

Minimum requirements for obtaining a filing date for a non-convention application

- Applicant's name and address
- Specification in any language
- Drawings, if any

Minimum requirements for obtaining a filing date for a convention application

- Applicant's name and address
 - Filing date, application number and country of each basic foreign application
- In this case no specification and no drawings are necessary for obtaining a filing date.*

2. VALIDATION OF EUROPEAN PATENTS

- Decision to grant of the European Patent Office
- Description and claims as granted for translation of the claims and eventually the description into Hungarian
- Drawings, if any
- Power of Attorney (can be filed later)

3. NATIONAL PHASE OF PCT APPLICATIONS

- Copy of the PCT application as published by the WIPO
- Copy of any amendment in the international phase and/or at entering the national phase
- Indication whether the international application is to be treated as an application for the grant of a patent or of a utility model
- Inventor's name and address, if not indicated in the PCT request
- International Search Report, preferably with copies of the listed documents
- International Preliminary Examination Report, if any
- Power of Attorney (can be filed later)
- Certified copy of each basic foreign application, if not submitted to the WIPO (can be filed later)
- Assignment Document, if applicant is not identical with the applicant as stated in the PCT documents (can be filed later)

4. SUPPLEMENTARY PROTECTION CERTIFICATES (SPCs)

- Applicant's name and address
- Registration number and title of the basic patent
- Name of the product (i.e. the title of the SPC)
- Chemical name of the product
- Name of the authorised medicinal or plant protection product
- Particulars (number and date of issue) and copy of the first marketing authorisation (MA) of the product for Hungary with its enclosures, and the date on which the owner was notified of the MA together with a document evidencing said date. If the MA was issued by the EMA, the MA and its enclosures in their authentic language and in Hungarian
- Particulars of the first MA in the Community, if different from the first MA for Hungary (number, date of issue, country of issue, product, legal provision under which the authorisation took place) and a copy of a document evidencing the grant of the MA (e.g. official publication). If the language of the document is other than English, German or French, a plain translation into any of said languages or into Hungarian
- Explanation by which claim of the basic patent and how the product is protected

5. TRADEMARKS

- Applicant's name and address
- The mark to be registered for wordmarks of standard characters
- Two-dimensional graphic or photographic representation, in colour if applies, for marks other than wordmarks of standard characters
- Reproduction in colour and the respective Pantone colour code for colour marks
- The type of the mark
- Specification containing the goods and/or services
- Power of Attorney
- For collective and certification marks, regulations governing the use of the mark

Additional requirements for convention applications

- Filing date, application number and country of each basic foreign application
- Certified copy of each basic foreign application, to be filed within 4 months from the filing date
- Hungarian or English translation of each certified copy, if it is not in any of these languages
- Assignment Document, if applicant is not identical with the applicant(s) of the basic foreign application(s)

Minimum requirements for obtaining a filing date for a non-convention application

- Applicant's name and address
- Specification containing the goods and/or services in any language
- The mark to be registered for wordmarks of standard characters
- Two-dimensional graphic or photographic representation, in colour if applies, for marks other than wordmarks of standard characters

Minimum requirements for obtaining a filing date for a convention application

- Applicant's name and address
 - Filing date, application number and country of each basic foreign application
- In this case no graphic or photographic representation of the mark and no specification are necessary for obtaining a filing date.*

6. DESIGNS

- Applicant's name and address
- Author's name and address
- Graphic or photographic representation of the design, or each of the designs (maximum of 50 designs)
- Indication of the product for which the design is to be used
- Power of Attorney
- Assignment Document, if applicant and author are not the same person

Additional requirements for convention applications

- Filing date, application number and country of each basic foreign application
- Certified copy of each basic foreign application, to be filed within 4 months from the filing date
- Assignment Document, if applicant is not identical with the applicant(s) of the basic foreign application(s)

Minimum requirements for obtaining a filing date for a non-convention application

- Applicant's name and address
- Graphic or photographic representation of the design, or each of the designs

Minimum requirements for obtaining a filing date for a convention application

- Applicant's name and address
 - Filing date, application number and country of each basic foreign application
- In this case no graphic or photographic representation of the design is necessary for obtaining a filing date.*

7. PLANT VARIETY PROTECTION

- Applicant's name and address
- Breeder's name and address (can be submitted later)
- Denomination of the plant variety
- Common name and Latin name of the species
- Description of the plant variety
- Photo(s) of the plant variety
- Declaration on novelty (can be filed later)
- Power of Attorney (can be filed later)
- Assignment Document, if applicant and breeder are not the same person (can be filed later)

8. MICROELECTRONIC SEMICONDUCTOR TOPOGRAPHIES

- Applicant's name and address
- Author's name and address
- Drawing(s) or photo(s) of the topography
- Power of Attorney (can be filed later)
- Assignment Document, if applicant and author are not the same person (can be filed later)

9. GEOGRAPHICAL DESIGNATIONS

- Applicant's name and address
- The geographical designation to be registered and its type (appellation of origin, geographical indication)
- List of products
- Product specification in case of agricultural products or foodstuffs
- Power of Attorney (can be filed later)

10. DOMAIN NAMES

Applications under the top level public domain (.hu)

- Application Form signed by the Applicant
- Copy of Applicant's Hungarian Trademark Registration, or European Community Trademark Registration, or International Registration extended to Hungary, for a trademark comprising the domain name
- Power of Attorney

Applications under the second level public domain (*.hu)

- Application Form signed by the Applicant
- Power of Attorney

In this case no registered trademark right in Hungary is necessary for obtaining a registration.
